## Brief Overview:

### *English:*

During this half term we will be basing our literacy lessons around our topic ie visit to the super market, where food comes from and growing. We will be looking for all the elements of spelling, punctuation and grammar throughout these lessons.

### *Maths:*

### *Computing: Control, algorithms and debugging*
