

FS2 School closure pack

Unfortunately the Covid-19 situation has reached a point where we have had to close. We will endeavour to update you in regard to the ongoing situation as regularly as possible.

This will be via **texts, twitter and the website** so please ensure you are checking these regularly.

We know that some parents/carers will be keen for their child to have some learning that they can access at home. We are aware that not all of the children will have internet access nor access to a device, therefore we have tried to include a mixture of paper/internet based learning.

Your child is bringing home a small pack of age related work that they could complete at home under your guidance should you wish to use it.

The F2 pack includes:

- A reading book
- An exercise book and pencil so they can record any of their learning
- Phonics activities
- Writing activities
- Maths activities

REMEMBER there are things to do in your child's home/school diary -

- Continue to read with your child 3+ times a week
- Practise spellings (pg11,12) and handwriting (pg9)
- Practise recognising, reading and writing the phonemes (pg10)
- Maths ideas and resources (pg13,14)
